NOTES

Saturdays - The committee want to the club to be used regularly on Saturdays, so there will be more organised events on Saturdays, and, where there is nothing organised, it is hoped that members will turn up for a sail and rig the Jeanneau on stand-by to use as a safety boat if necessary.

1. **Saturday 31st March** - There will be safety boat cover, and the kitchen will be open for business.
2. **Power boat level 2** - Power boat training for those members who have not completed level 2 will be available on Saturdays 7th, 14th, and 21st April. Please contact Peter Crooks (01723 513537 or peter@pcrooks.co.uk).
3. **Junior Races** (for members aged 18 and under on the 1st January 2012) - The 10 race series will be held on Saturdays starting on 16th June.
4. **The Lord Birkett Trophy at Ullswater** - 2012's race will be the 50th and Ullswater YC promise that it will be special. It's well worth a weekend away, even if you don't enter the races.
5. **The King George Shield** has always been a one off handicap Sunday afternoon race in the past, but, this year, it will be a new Saturday event utilising the club Picos and Omegas. There will be a windward – leeward course set up and all entrants will be timed over the course in Picos and Omegas. For the Omega races, we could draw for partners and then complete the course both as helm and crew. The exact format will be up to the OOD, but it should be a full day's fun.
